In 1885 Deepwater was proclaimed a Village. The coming of the railway in 1886 greatly increased the work at the Post Office. It was the centre for mail to Emmaville and Torrington.

Around 1913/14 the present Post Office and residence was built in its present location.

We all know how valuable our local Post Office is to the community. On 22nd March 1948 permission was given to have mail delivered to the community by bicycle – and the service commenced 1st April 1948. There are 54 Post Office boxes available, and all are taken.

There have been faithful Postmasters over the time and our present beloved Postmaster Russ Hutchinson has been working here since 1966.

Lots of travellers drop in and it is a pleasure to work there as a volunteer.

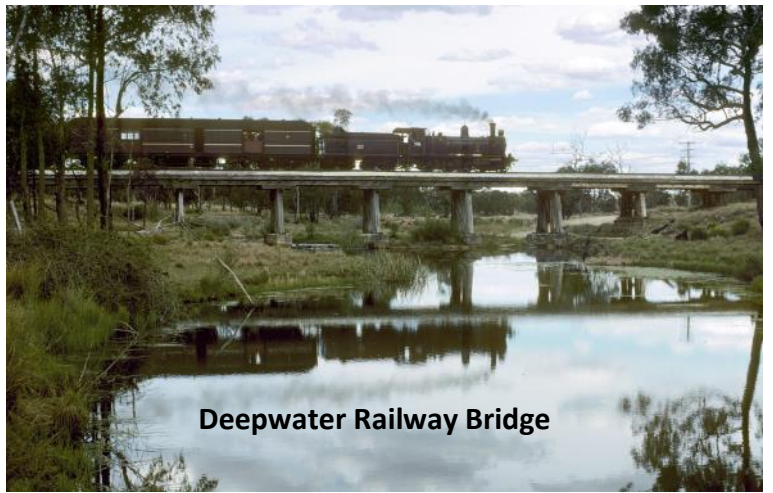

Deepwater Railway Bridge

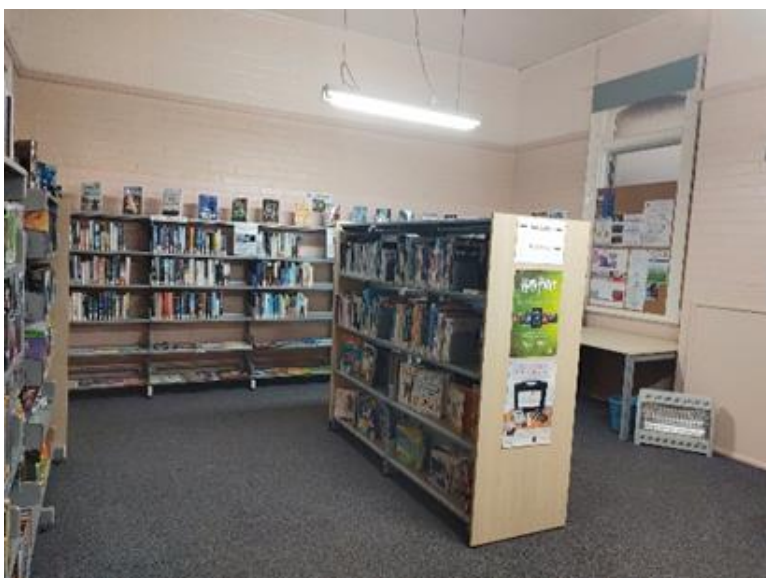

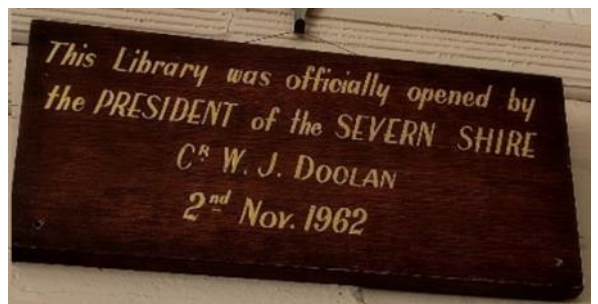

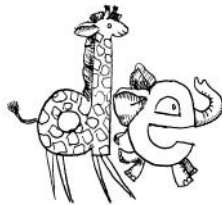
